## **Transportation**

Trinity Motor Coach will be providing transportation to and from Carmel, and will also transport the students and chaperones while in Indianapolis. A minimum of fifteen (15) parent chaperones will be riding with the students at all times while on the motor coach. Bus safety rules will be strictly adhered to according to the Walled Lake School district policy.

## Meals

Most, <u>but not all</u>, meals will be provided to the students and chaperones. Our food menu has taken into account special dietary needs.

The meals that will be provided to the students and official chaperones are:

Breakfast: Hotel includes breakfast each day.

Lunch & Dinner: Friday, and Saturday.

The meals that are not provided are:

Saturday: If we do not make Semi-Finals, kids will go to the mall and will need

money to buy food and souvenirs.

Sunday: Bring money for lunch on the way back to WLC.

## **Performance Tickets**

The competition performance schedule is as follows:

- Nov 9, Friday Preliminaries:
  - Walled Lake Central Marching Band performs at 7:00 PM.
  - General admission \$25 each. 2-Day prelim. ticket \$38 each
- Nov 10, Saturday Semi-Finals
  - o top 30-34 bands, plus exhibition(s)
  - General admission \$40 each
  - Finals (6:45pm) top 12 bands plus Awards Ceremony. Reserved seating, advance tickets highly recommended. These can be as high as \$55.

Grand Nationals Finals competition tickets for Saturday Nov 10 at 7:00 pm, showcasing the top 12 marching bands, at the Lucas Oil Stadium are available in advance and are reserved seating only. Tickets can be purchased online on the Bands of America website <a href="www.musicforall.org">www.musicforall.org</a> or <a href="Ticket Master">Ticket Master</a> or Lucas Oil Stadium Ticket Office. It is highly recommended that you purchase your Finals tickets in advance. Tickets are also available through Ticketmaster.

Finals tickets for students, chaperones, and staff will be purchased shortly. Do not purchase Finals tickets for your student or yourself if you are an official chaperone.

(Chaperones are asked to cover the cost of their own preliminary tickets). If you prefer to sit near the band during finals, we can tell you what area to consider and ask for.

## <u>Parking</u>

Located adjacent to Lucas Oil Stadium is N.K. Hurst Co. parking lot @ 230 W. Mc Carty Street on Friday and Saturday. (25) \$10 parking passes are available to purchase for each day. Tailgate and band meetings for Saturday will take place in the grassy section of Hurst Co. parking lot.

There will also be additional parking lots nearby at the same \$10/day rate.

## Items To Bring - LABEL ALL PIECES and Bag check form

- \*Personal items (clothes & toiletries). We will be spending a lot of time outdoors, so make sure you dress appropriately. A small/medium overnight bag should be sufficient. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO CARRY THEIR OWN LUGGAGE.
- \*All meds must be given to the student's chaperone and will be administered by the designated adult on duty.
- \*Sleeping bag, pillow, and/or inflatable air mattress if desired. (Some kids might not want to share a bed.)
- \*Full Uniform, White Band shirt, black shoes (Dinkels), and multiple pairs of socks. Must turn in before practice on Wednesday, November 7, 2018.
- \*Instrument, supplies (tape, sticks, mallets, reeds, gloves, etc.)
- \*Backpack/day bag for daily necessities.
- \*Please, no coolers. It is not necessary to bring extra food as the students will be fed. However, they are allowed to bring their own snacks.
- \*Money for lunch/snacks at the Mall, and lunch on Sunday and miscellaneous spending. Of course, there is always "event stuff" to purchase, such as event t-shirts and DVD's of the show.
- \*Families: Bring a lawn chair and EZ-Up type portable canopies if you have one for shade (or shelter from the rain), stadium blanket & seat cushion for watching practices, if desired.

## Medication

It is the Walled Lake School District policy that **all prescription medication be stored and administered by a designated adult.** Over the counter (OTC) medication will also be administered by a designated adult <u>only</u> if the OTC form for that student is on file with WLCMB.

\*An Authorization to Administer Medication form must be completed by your physician, and on file with WLCMB.

\*Bring just enough medication for the trip in the labeled prescription container and in the same dosage described on the medication form. Place in a Ziploc bag with the name clearly printed on the bag. **Give all medications to the chaperone prior to leaving.** The student will be responsible for coming to the designated adult to receive their medication.
