## Instructions for Counseling / Performing Arts Departments

Shuman Dealership donated \$50,000 in August 2014 to the Foundation for Excellence–Walled Lake Schools for the establishment of the Shuman Chrysler Dodge Jeep RAM Performing Arts Student Grant Program. An endowment fund has been created and affords the disbursement of student grants totaling \$2,000+ annually.

- **INTENT:** Grants are intended to broaden student involvement in the WLCSD’s high school performing arts by offsetting the cost of participation and/or registration fee, where financial assistance is essential in sustaining involvement or establishing membership.
- **INVITATION:** WLCSD educator, counseling office and/or performing arts dept. shall extend invitation to students to complete grant application where financial constraints (hardship) are perceived. Statement from referring personnel may be forwarded to the Foundation for Excellence-Walled Lake Schools ([michellebianco@wlcsc.org](mailto:michellebianco@wlcsc.org)), but is not mandatory.
- **PARAMETERS:** Applicant may request funding for (1) performing arts program. Grant will be awarded for singular school year and student remains eligible to re-apply for subsequent years once awarded grant. Awards will be announced spring 2020 and applicable for performing arts programs beginning in the summer or 2020/2021 school year.
- **REQUIREMENT:** Application must identify referring WLCSD educator, counselor or performing arts instructor in order to be considered.

**DEADLINE & DETAILS:** Application due **April 14, 2020**

- Grants will be awarded based on funding’s impact as cited by applicant and/or where the greatest financial need is perceived as highlighted by educator/counselor/performing arts instructor and according to overall merit of application.
- The Foundation for Excellence will notify applicants of grant award. The referring WLCSD educator will be contacted so plans can be established to present grants.
- Disbursement will be made directly to performing arts program on grant recipient’s behalf.
